Pre-Departure

NOTES

This checklist is printed out and taped inside mug kitchen cabinet

BEFORE YOU DRIVE AWAY

- ☐ Confirm your primary destination, backup if primary is unreachable
- ☐ Text your out-of-area contact: you are evacuating, route, destination
- ☐ Set GPS to primary route and keep alternate route in mind
- ☐ Headlights on, AC set to recirculate to keep smoke out

INSIDE THE HOME

- ☐ Close all windows and exterior doors (do not lock)
- ☐ Close all interior doors to slow fire spread
- ☐ Close and block all pet doors
- ☐ Turn on all interior and exterior lights
- ☐ Move flammable furniture and curtains away from windows
- ☐ Turn off propane at tank or natural gas at meter if instructed
- ☐ Unplug non-essential electronics

OUTSIDE THE HOME

- ☐ Connect garden hoses to spigots and leave them visible for firefighters
- ☐ Move firewood, propane tanks, and lawn furniture at least 30 feet from structures
- ☐ Close exterior shutters or non-combustible blinds
- ☐ Park vehicles facing out, windows up, keys near ignition
- ☐ Leave all gates unlocked for emergency responders

PEOPLE & PETS

- ☐ Do a headcount to account for every person and pet
- ☐ Grab go-bags for every household member
- ☐ Take all medications and prescription list
- ☐ Grab phone, charger, wallet, ID, keys
- ☐ Pets leashed, in carriers, or in vehicle
- ☐ Pack pet food, water, meds, and vet records
- ☐ Wear long sleeves, long pants, closed shoes, leather gloves
- ☐ Bring N95 masks or bandanas for smoke

If You're Not Home

KIDS & SCHOOL

- ☒ Know your kids' school evacuation protocol
- ☒ Designate authorized pickup contacts at the school
- ☐ Make sure your kids know which adults can pick them up
- ☐ Have a family reunification plan

PETS

- ☒ Designate a trusted person who can get your pets out
- ☒ Make sure they know where pet carriers, leashes, and food are kept
- ☐ Share your vet's contact info and any boarding plan with the proxy
- ☐ Confirm your pet ID tags and microchip info are current

PLAN VISIBILITY

- ☐ Store your full evacuation plan somewhere accessible to a trusted person
- ☐ Tell at least one out-of-household person where your plan lives

TRUSTED PROXY

- ☒ Designate a trusted neighbor or nearby friend with a house key
- ☒ Share your evacuation plan with that proxy
- ☐ Give the proxy permission to act on your behalf
- ☐ Establish an out-of-area contact
- ☐ Make sure every household member knows the out-of-area contact's number

INSURANCE & FINANCIAL

- ☒ Insurance policies recorded
- ☐ Belongings inventoried
- ☒ Emergency cash on hand

MEDICAL & CRITICAL

- ☒ Health and insurance cards compiled

STORAGE & ACCESS

- ☒ Copies stored off-site or in the cloud
- ☒ One set in your go-bag
- ☐ A trusted person can access them

Roles & Responsibilities

COMMUNICATION & RENDEZVOUS

- ☒ Meeting point known by all
- ☐ Key numbers carried by everyone
- ☐ Check-in protocol agreed

- ☒ Out-of-area contact named
- ☐ Lead decision-maker identified
